

VILLAGE OF ROSEDALE
Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the
Board of Aldermen
October 9, 2024

The Board of Aldermen of the Village of Rosedale met in regular session on Tuesday, October 9, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Riley J. Blanchet, presiding, Alderman Dana Alexander, Carroll Devillier and Alderman Tim Doiron. Support staff members present were Attorney Jerry Guillot, Fire Chief Danny Gantt, Clerk Courtney Bourgoyne and Deputy Clerk Freedom Hutchinson.

Alderman Devillier led those present in prayer. Fire Chief Danny Gantt led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Alderman Alexander made a motion, seconded by Alderman Doiron to accept the minutes of the September 10, 2024 regular meeting as presented.

Alderman Devillier made a motion, seconded by Alderman Doiron to accept the September financial statement as presented, including budget actual comparison, and showing a balance in all accounts combined of \$4,896,745.88.

The Board agreed to set Trick-R-Treat hours from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, October 31, 2024.

Alderman Alexander introduced an ordinance TO ENACT SECTION 11.2(C) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPENSATION OF THE FIRE CHIEF; AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATIVE MATTERS.

Alderman Doiron made a motion, seconded by Alderman Devillier to accept a donation from Albany Police Department of a 2010 Chevrolet Tahoe to Rosedale Police Department.

Attorney Guillot brought up the discussion on the petition for annexation presented by Calvin Andre. After a brief explanation and discussion the board agreed to table the petition for annexation.

Fire Chief Danny Gantt reported that the fire department received 10 calls in September. He also reported that the Rosedale Fire Department hosted the chiefs meeting in September and had several compliments on the new fire station by several attendees. He further reported that the fire rating will be conducted on October 22, 2024.

Police Chief Mike Sparks was absent so no report was available.

Attorney Jerry Guillot reported that the town bought the A. W. Basco park property in 1978. He also reported that the dirt road on the south side of the A. W. Basco Park property is not a public road.

Mayor Blanchet reported that the trees on town property at the corner of Hwy 411 and Rosedale Road and property on Center Street will be cut down next week.

Alderman Doiron made a motion, seconded by Alderman Devillier to accept all departmental reports.
